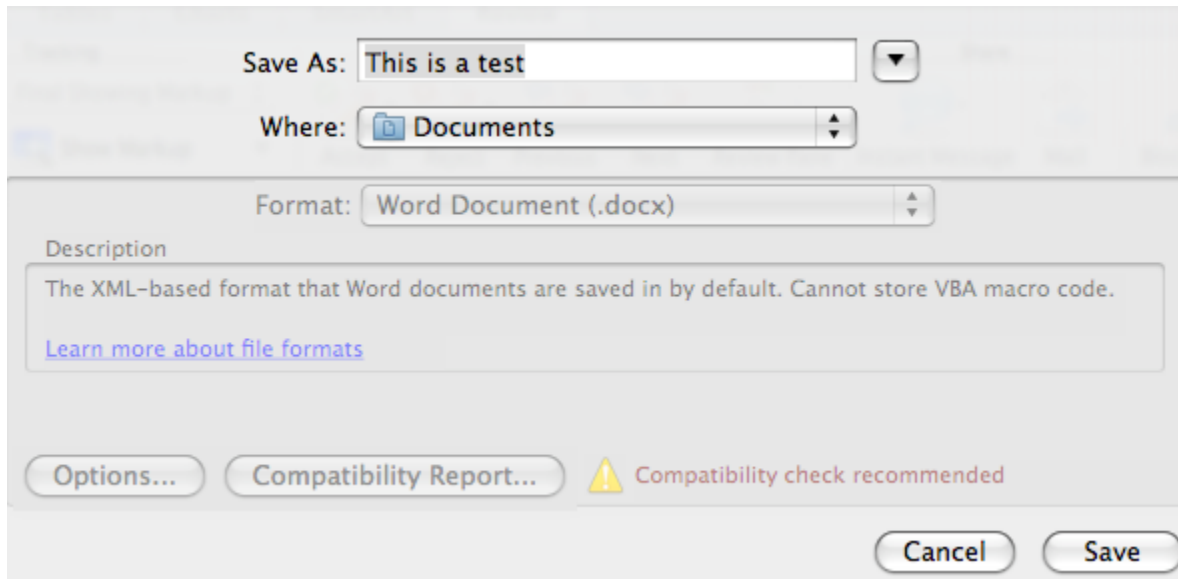


Opening Apple iWork Document on a PC

Option1 → You can save the iWork's document in a .docx or .doc format by doing this on a MAC:

- Select File
- Select Save
- In “Save As” Enter: (name of file)
- In “Format” Enter: Word Document (.docx) or Word Document Stationery (.doc)



Option 2 → To change the extension of the iWork's document to read it on a PC. A PDF of each document is embedded within the file from iWork's, and you can extract that PDF file with a little work. Do the following:

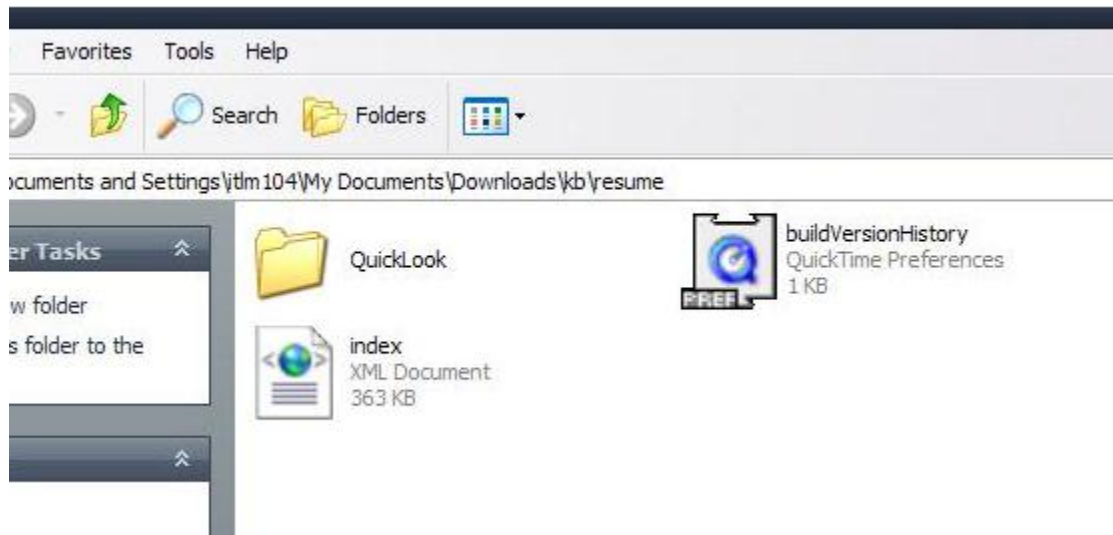
From a PC:

- Step 1: Save the file somewhere on the computer, such as the desktop. In this example, "resume" is the filename, and ".pages" is the file extension.



- Step 2: Change the file extension from ".pages" to ".zip". This will cause the icon to change appearance.
- Step 3: Double click the icon, and extract the .zip file.
- Step 4: Once extracted, a folder will be created with the same name as the .pages document. In this case, the folder is called "resume". Open the folder.

This is what you see:



- Step 5: Open the Quick Look folder, and inside you will find a PDF of the original file. You can open, print the PDF.
